It still does that even now, however it diversified into Food Processing and Supply for wholesalers and retailers. It recently expanded into Meals Ready to Eat (MRE) ration packs designed for miners.

MEALS READY TO EAT (MRE) RATION PACKS

These Meals Ready to Eat (MRE) are manufactured and packed in laboratories that are SANAS approved and quality is guaranteed to be of highest quality and of exceptional hygiene standards.





Our Meals Ready to Eat (MRE) ration packs have a life span of 2 years when stored at ambient temperatures. They are packaged for convenience and ease of use by miners, outdoor goers, military people, campers, hikers and fishermen. These meals are available in standard menus and some can be customised depending on clients' nutritional composition requirements. The main objective of our MRE's is to ensure that individuals are able to maintain high levels of performance and thereby become more productive.

We have adopted a zero-tolerance approach to health and safety of our foods. We also have a zero-harm strategy that fosters safe attitudes and behaviours of our employees. We also comply with WFSO 22000 that encompasses hazard analysis and critical control points (HACCP). AGRO-PROCESSING

Our agro-processing unit is committed to offering the best services to our clients. Foods in this unit are processed under controlled environment that replicates the natural environment to maintain freshness and premium quality. Every step of the process is observed for neatness, health, safety and quality.

HORTICULTURE

This business unit includes washing, sorting, and packaging of fruits and vegetables. Our in-house horticulture department provides specialized support to our network of dedicated growers. Expert supervision is done on-farm productivity to ensure good quality harvest. Fruits and vegetables that we distribute are organically grown on different farms. They are then packed into large bins on the orchards and then transported to our factory in Alberton where the final cleaning, grading, sorting and packaging into specified cartons for the market is done.

The final products are then boxed, palletized and stored in our huge storehouse ready to be dispatched by means of road freight for local deliveries and by air freight for exports. We have a tracking and storage software that we use to trace all dispatched goods from our warehouse.

FEEDING SCHEMES

Last but not least, our Food Services division supplies nutritional food to hunger relief organizations in South Africa. Our 10 years of experience in the feeding scheme industry vouches for our ability to give profoundly nutritious food at the most minimal conceivable costs to feeding schemes. We supply daily meals to more than 30 000 people through our partner feeding organizations. The feeding scheme specialises in packing and supplying of low-cost food parcels, supplying bulk food to soup kitchens, and supplying pre-schools and underprivileged schools.
